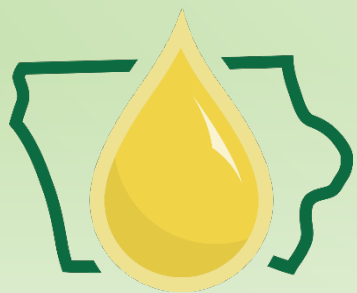

Historical Corn Yield and Production

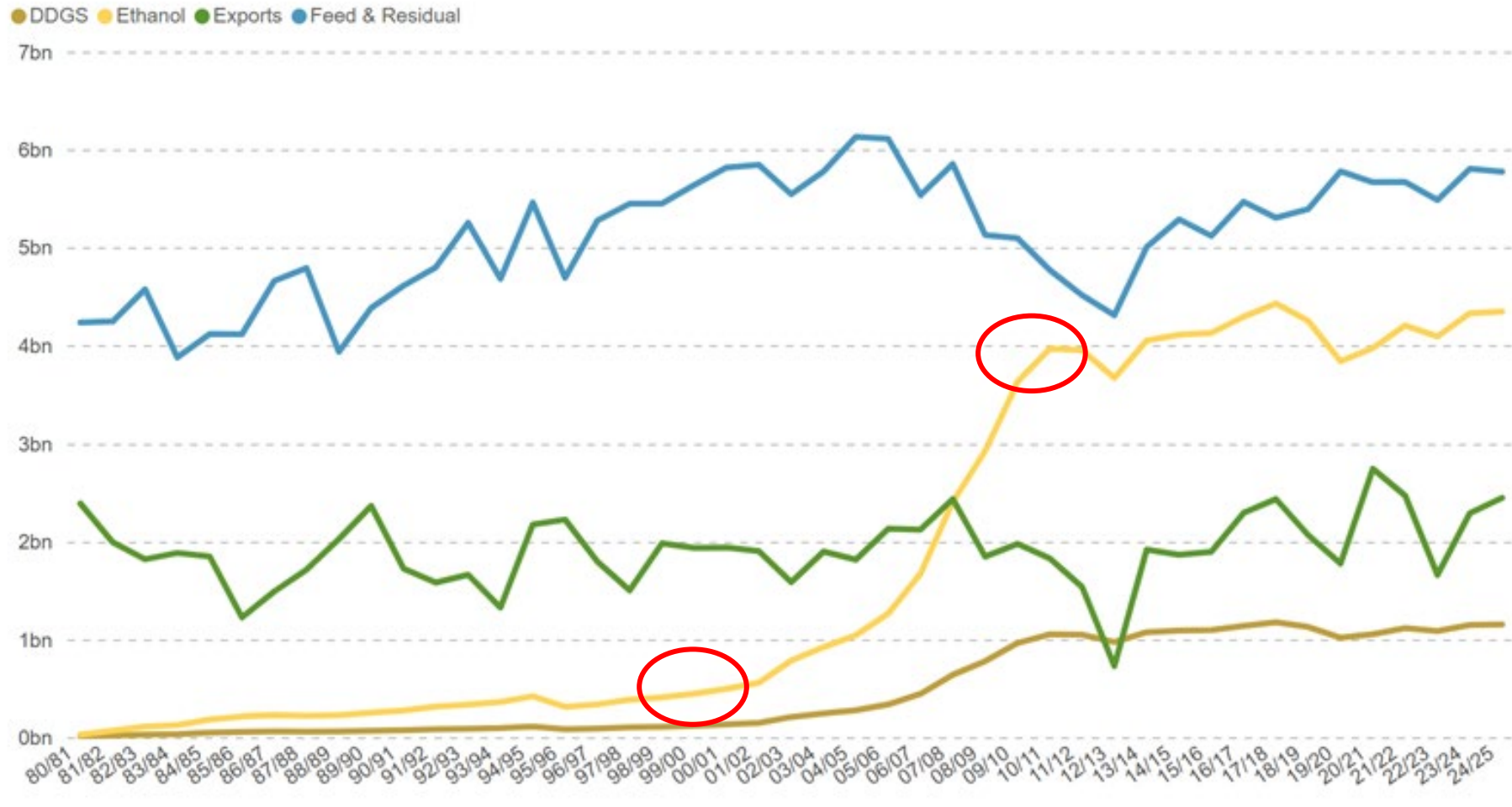

MY80/81 – MY24/25* U.S. Corn Usage Summary (Bu)



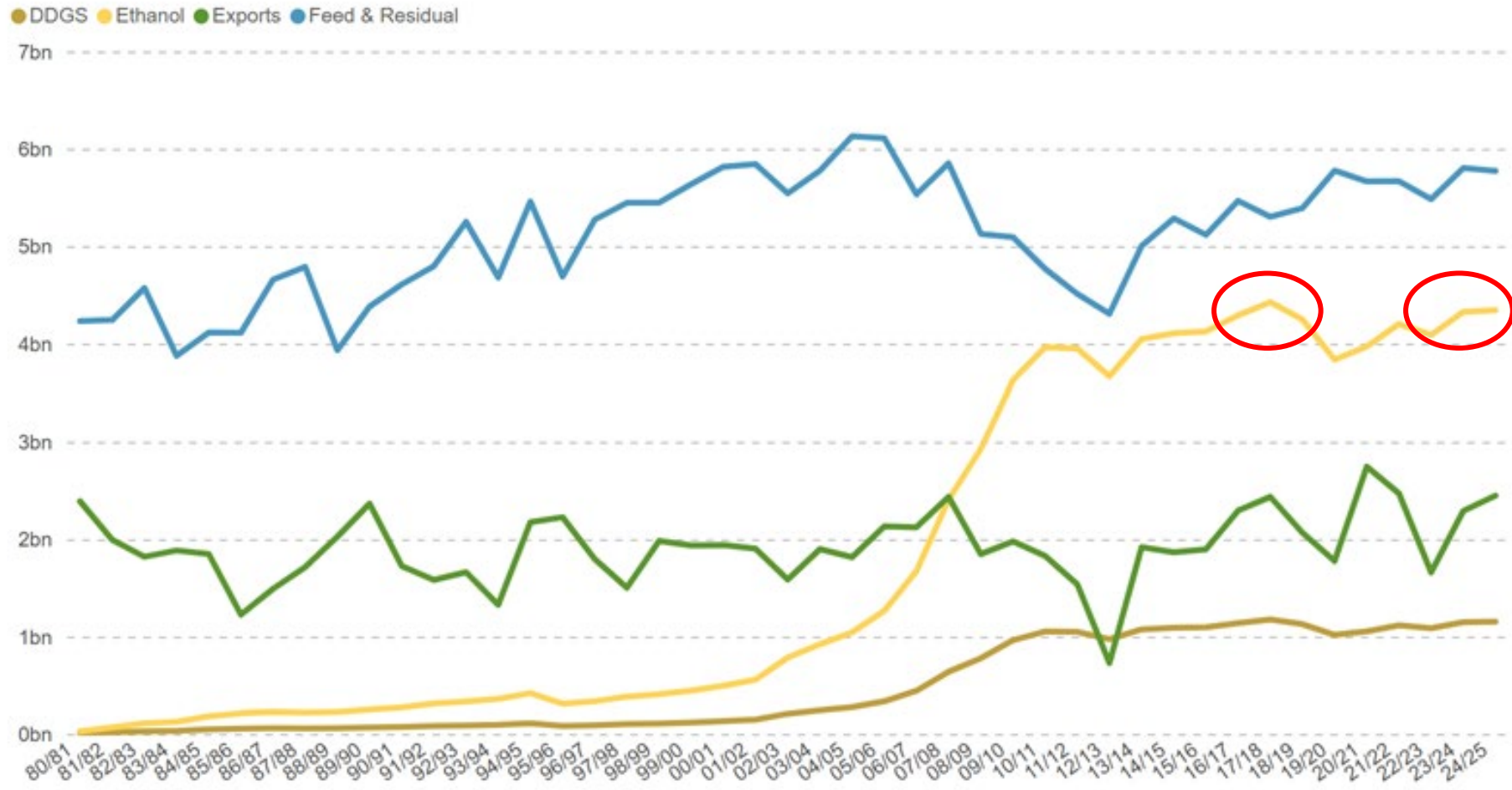
